Rules

1. All campers must register upon arriving at camp with the camp registrar. All campers must turn in their money to the registrar. Each camper upon completion of registration, should report to his or her assigned cabin.
2. Campers are not allowed to leave the campgrounds at any time without permission from the camp director.
3. All campers must attend, and be on time to, all scheduled events unless your cabin leader has excused you.
4. There will be no girls in the boys' cabins or cabin area, or any boys in the girls' cabins or cabin area.
5. Use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or drugs by campers and staff is not permitted. Any violation of this rule may cause the camper to be expelled immediately from the camp at the discretion of the camp director.
6. No laptops, mp3 players, CELL PHONES, or other electronic devices are allowed. If you have one with you, please check it in with your cabin leader.
7. Help us keep the grounds and buildings clean. Don't be a litterbug! You are responsible for any camp or personal property damage.
8. Do not pull or cut bark, branches, or leaves from any trees on the campground.
9. Cups, utensils, or any other property of the kitchen shall not be taken from the dining hall.
10. There will be no handholding or display of affection between boys and girls at any time.
11. Clothing should be modest: (Do they glorify God?) T-shirts with logos should be in good taste.
 1. Swimming is permitted only at regularly scheduled recreation hours. Swimming is done only in the area outlined by the lifeguard. You must have a buddy to swim.
 2. Canoes are to be used only during regular scheduled recreation period and only when a cabin leader accompanies the campers in the canoes. All those using canoes MUST WEAR A LIFE PRESERVER AT ALL TIMES.
 3. When going to the waterfront, adjacent homes south of our campground are off limits to all campers. Traffic must be on the roads rather than across the lawns of these homes.

Checking Out
