Fault Lake is a great destination located in the Selkirk Range. It is one of three lakes in the general area (Hunt Lake and McCormick Lake being the other two) all of which are unique in their own way. There are wonderful views along the trail and on the ridgelines between the lakes. This is truly an area where God's creativity can be seen and experienced!

The trip starts at CLBC, where we will gear up, go over the trip plan, and discuss backcountry safety and ethics. We leave CLBC and travel to the trailhead on the Upper Pack River Road and begin the 6 mile hike. During the four-day, three-night trip, campers will enjoy day hikes, survival skills, and fellowship. Each day will include Bible studies in order to focus campers on the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the glory of God.

This trip is intended for teens of all skill levels but is considered an intermediate level hike and we ask that campers have some preliminary experience prior to coming on this trip (contact us for further clarification on appropriate experience). One of our other backing trips will prepare the camper for this level of hike. We will provide a safe environment where teens can experience the challenge of hiking and backpacking with new and old friends. Registrations must be in by August 1, 2019. We will send out a letter to campers one week prior to the trip with final details.

Basic Trip Information

Campers will learn the principles of lightweight backpacking and backpacking ethics in a Gospel-centered environment.

Campers will be equipped with the basic backpacking essentials (see back), and will be asked to bring personal items. Each person will carry his/her own gear.

The trip will begin August 22, 2019 at 10:00 AM at Cocolalla Lake Bible Camp, where we will car-pool to the trailhead. We will be camping at Fault Lake for three nights, and will take multiple day hikes in the area. Campers will return to CLBC by 4:00 PM on August 25, 2019.
